How To Edit Mockup

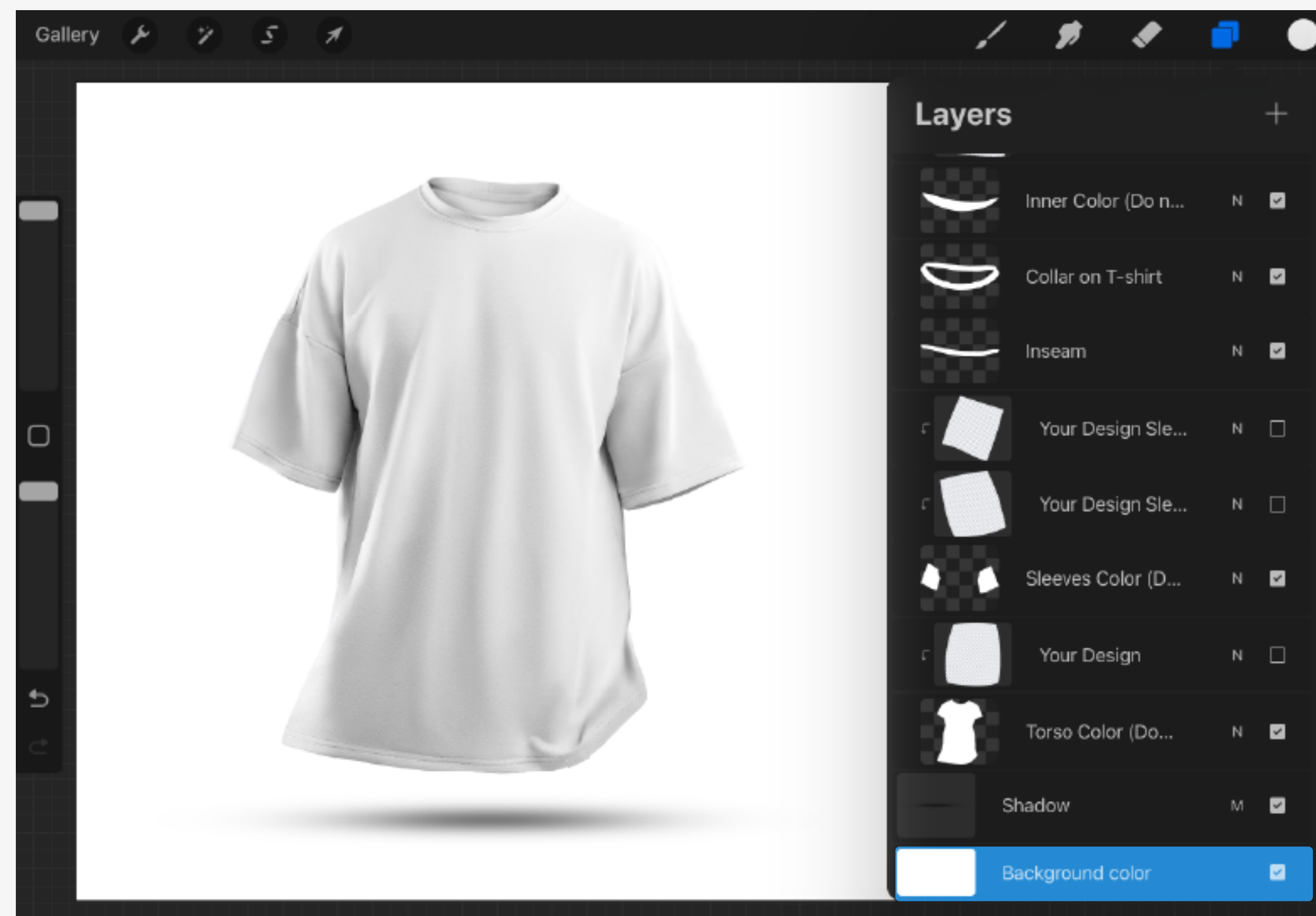
Basic Settings

- › Background
- › Color
- › Design
- › Texture

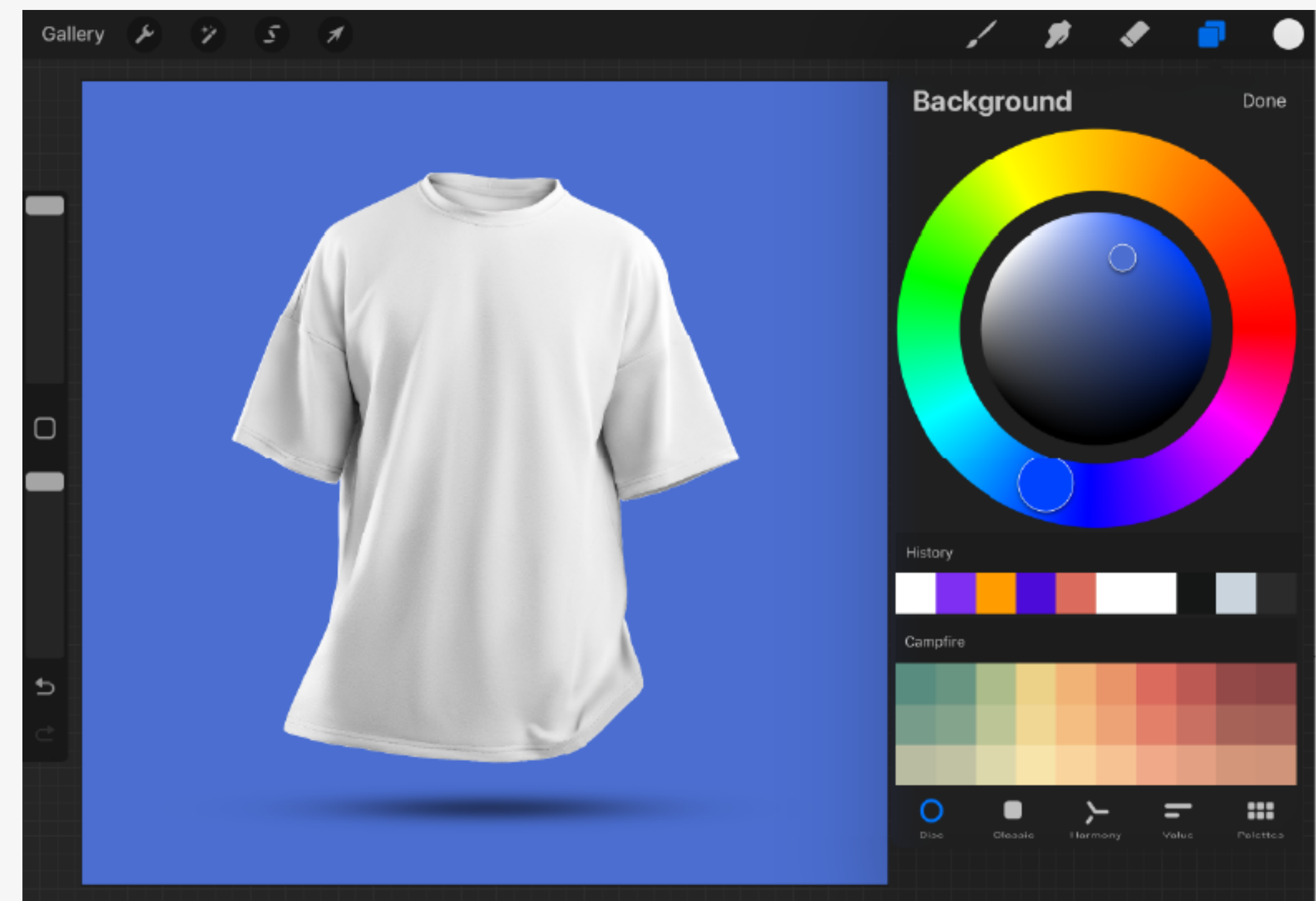
Background

You can change the background color, or use any of your own images for the background (insert the file on a new layer above the background)

- ! Layers in some products may vary. These may be additional backgrounds or shapes.
- You can edit them by the same principle, disable and enable their visibility.



Select a layer called «Background»

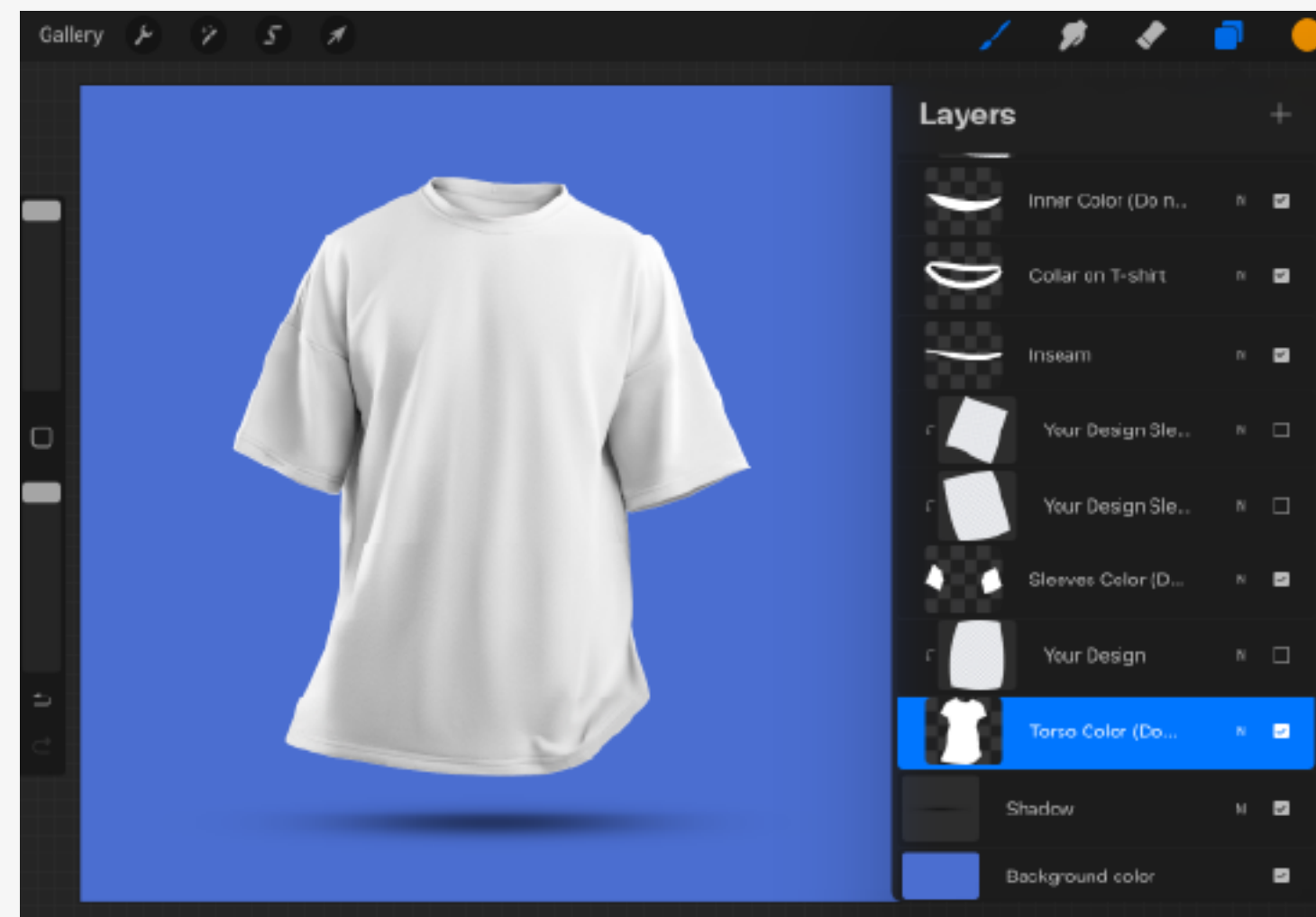


Choose the desired color and click "Done"

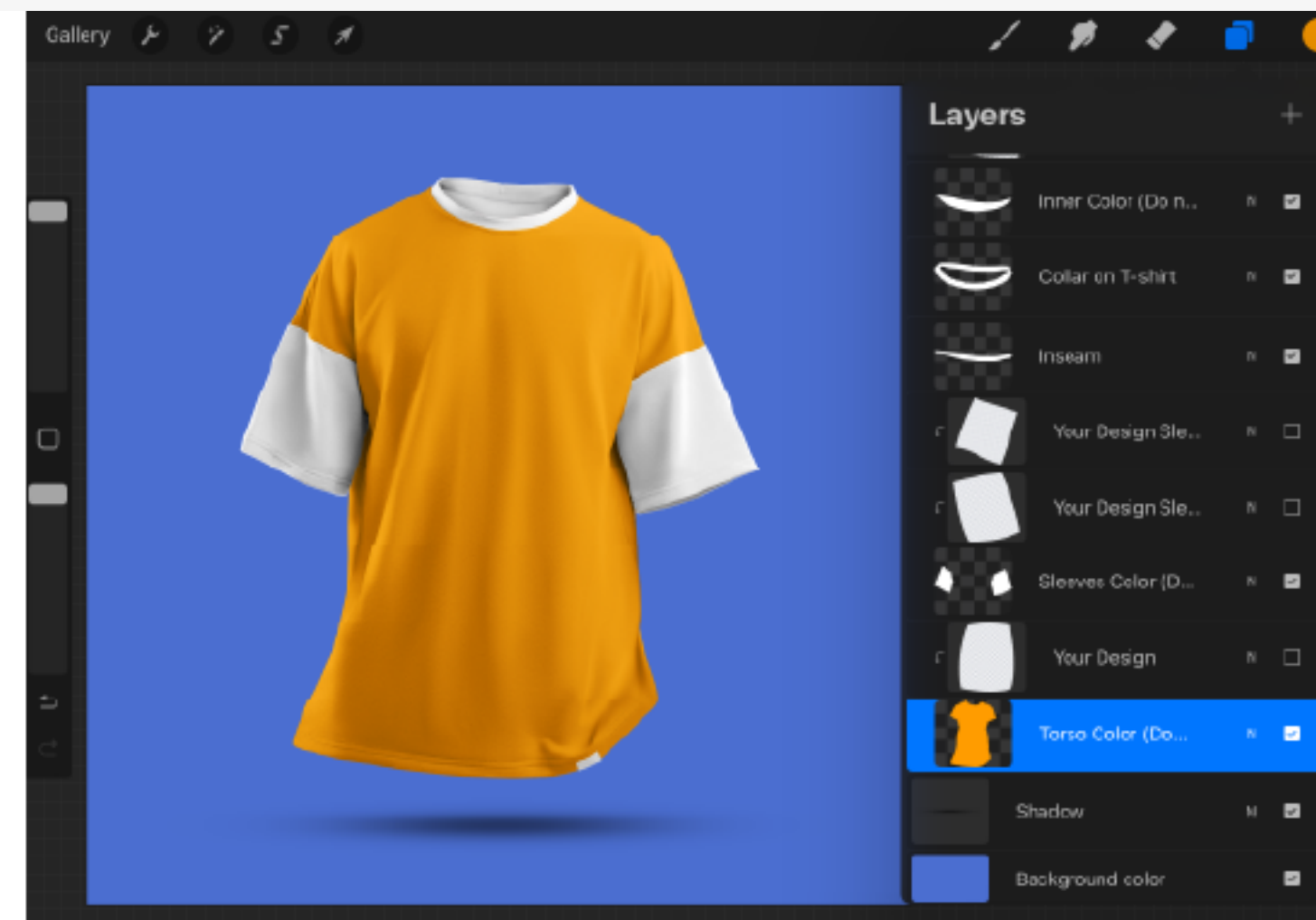
Colors

You can customize any color of clothes and its elements, controlling the result in real time

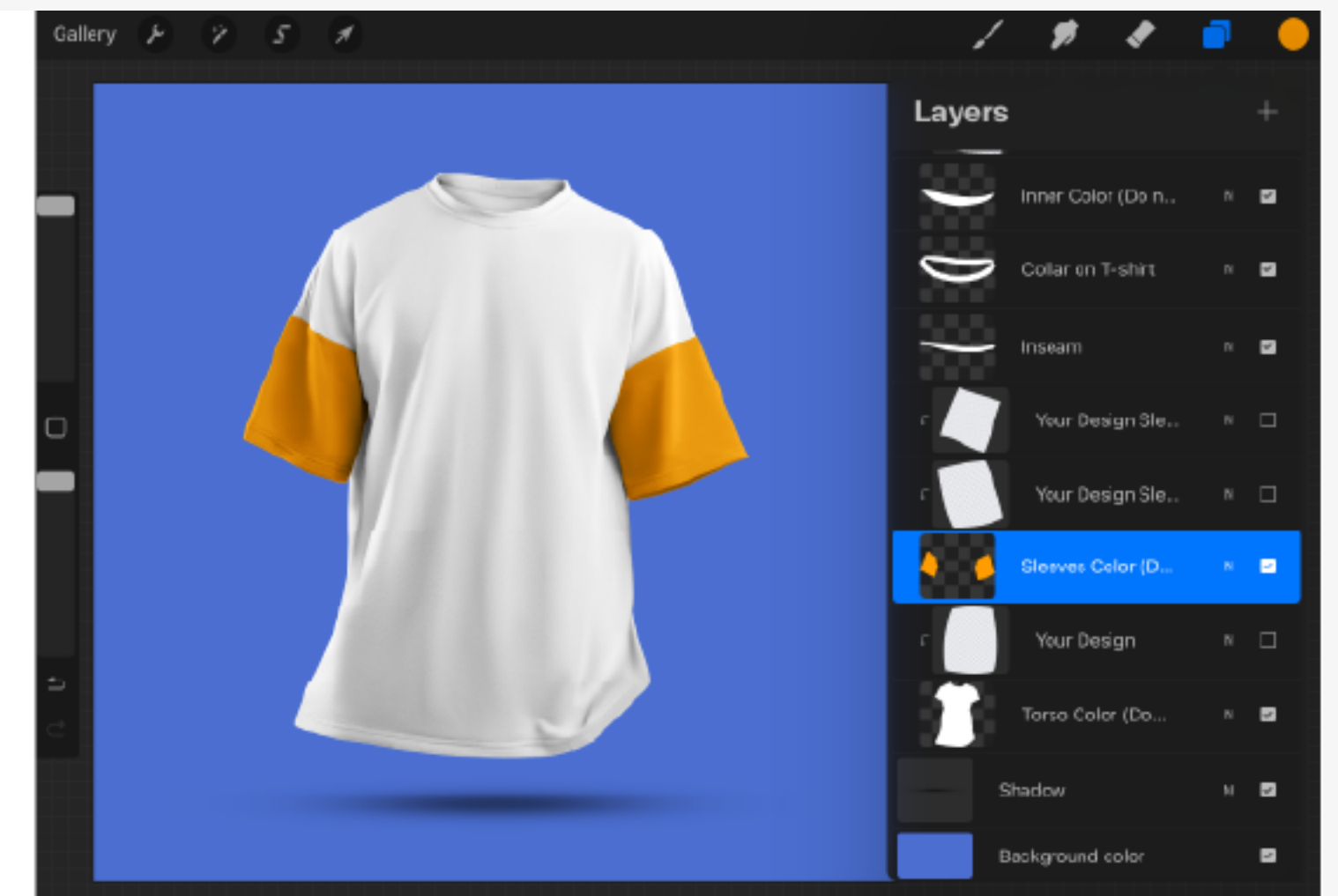
! Depending on the type of product, from 1 to 10 (maybe more) a layer
● for editing colors and template elements



Choose a layer with the appropriate name (torso, sleeves, collar, etc.), and paint it with a color of your choice, or paint it with a brush



Do not perform the "clean" function of the layer, just fill it with the desired color

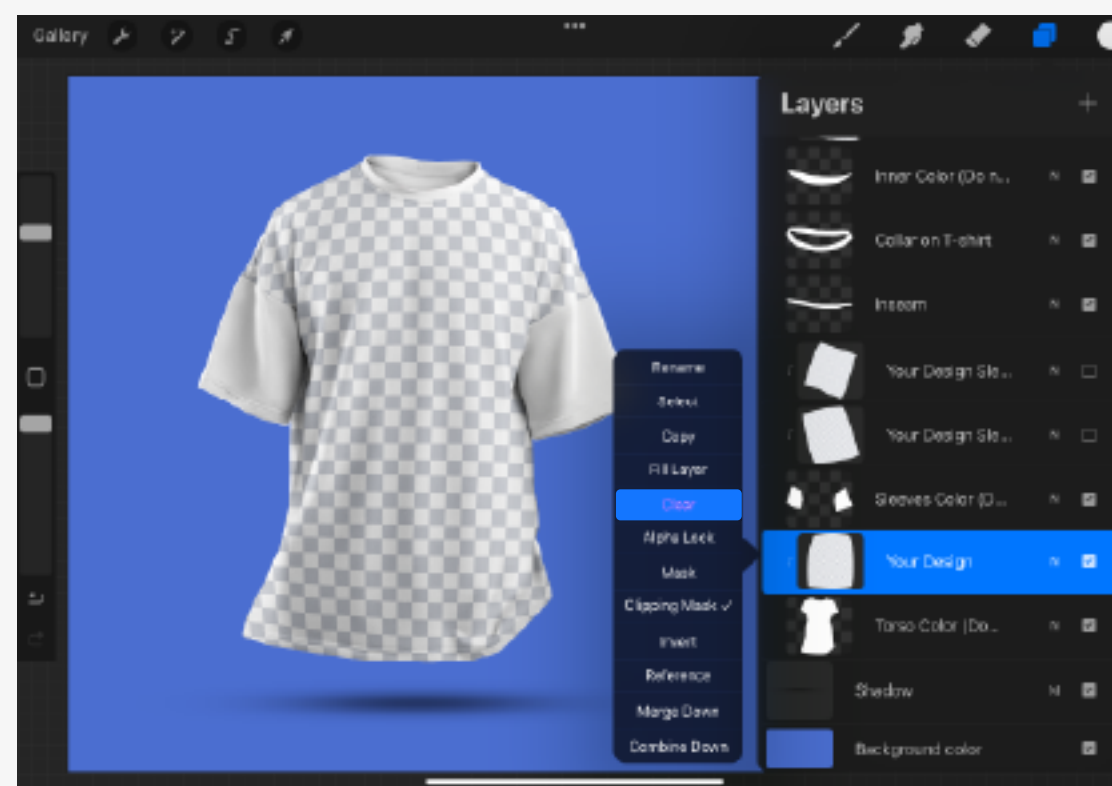


If necessary, repeat the same actions for other color layer

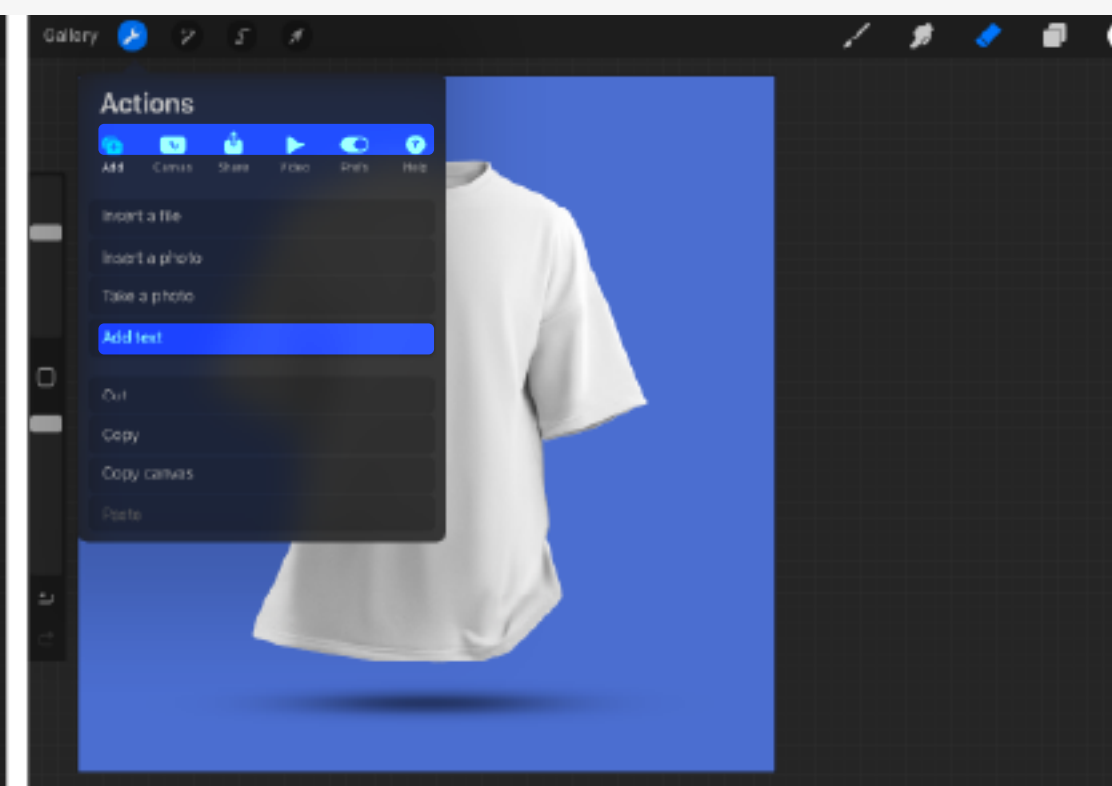
Design

Use any design for clothes. Any pattern can be used for t-shirts, labels, sleeves.

! Depending on the type of product, from 1 to 10 (maybe more) a layer for editing design and template elements



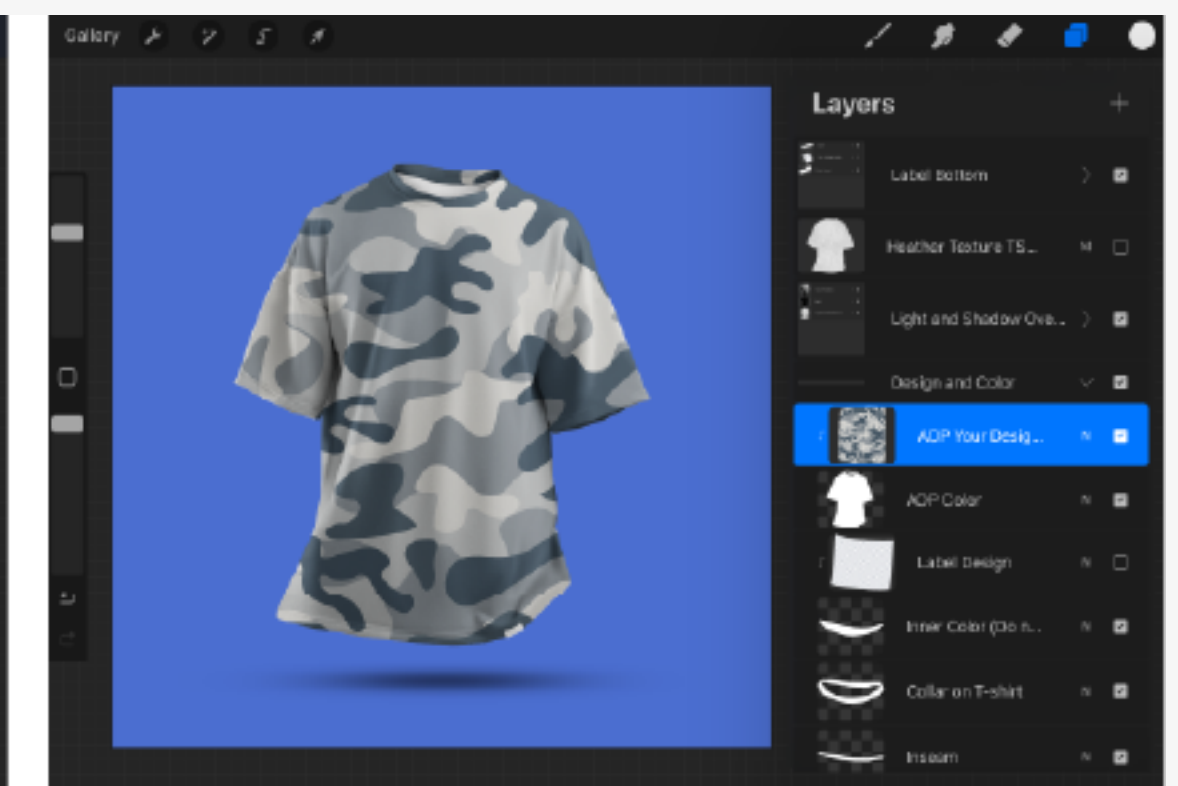
Select the layer with the appropriate name (torso, sleeves, collar, etc.) and turn it on and perform the "clean" function on the layer



Insert your own design on the corresponding layer (sleeve, torso, label or other) or apply the corresponding pattern using brushes.



Scale, transform and move your design and place it in the appropriate place

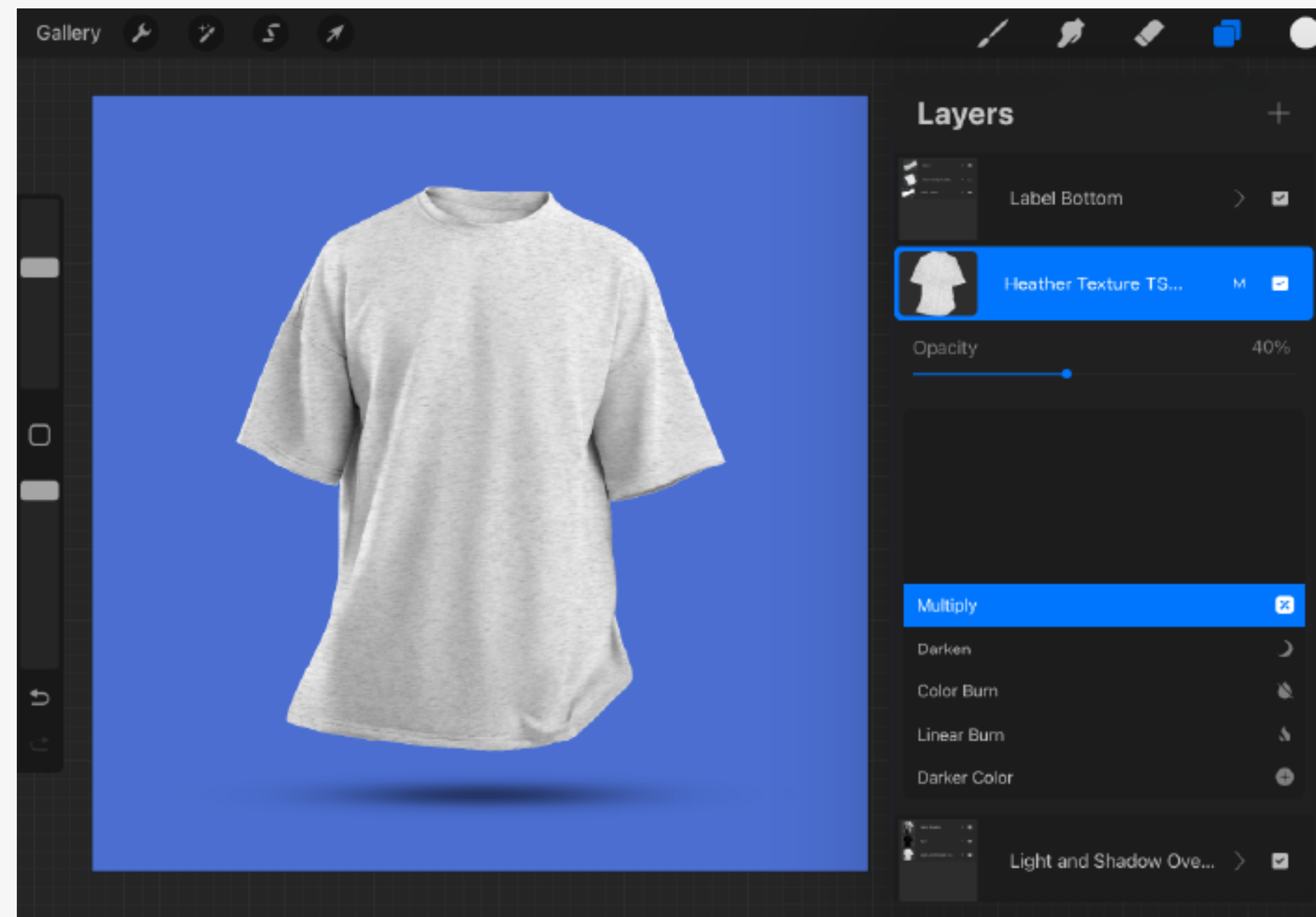


Use the AOP Design or Color layer to apply the pattern to the entire t-shirt

Texture

You can use the optional Heather texture.
Texture applied to any color of clothing.

! In some versions of mockups
"TECHTURE" may not be available.



Turn on the Texture layer and adjust the
transparency as needed.
